Hon'ble CEM of BTR, Shri Pramod Boro has launched today Mission Bwiswmuthi Awareness Week programme starting from 16th February 2024 to 22nd February 2024 in presence of Executive Members of BTC in the Conference Hall of DC's Office, Chirang.

Hon'ble CEM and Executive Members released IEC materials consisting of user manuals, Informative videos in all vernacular languages and awareness materials etc., on Mission Bwiswmuthi.

Mission Bwiswmuthi in line with Mission Basundhara aims to deliver all land related services through 19 nos. of Circle Offices of BTC through online in a time bound manner and under the Right to Public Services Act notified by the Government.

The present Mission (Mission Bwiswmuthi 1.0) focuses on providing the following thirteen services:

- 1. Mutation by right of inheritance
- 2. Mutation After Deed Registration
- 3. Partition
- 4. Reclassification of agricultural land to non-agricultural land
- 5. Allotment certificate to Periodic Patta (AC to PP)
- 6. Conversion from Annual Patta to Periodic Patta (AP to PP)
- 7. Area Correction
- 8. Striking out of the name from Patta
- 9. Name Correction
- 10. Mobile Number Updation
- 11. Certified Copy of Jamabandi
- 12. Certified Copy of Chitha
- 13. Land Holding Certificate

Digitization of land records and delivery of land related services through Mission Bwiswmuthi by BTC is first of its kind in the entire Country amongst the 6th Schedule administered places.

From now on, citizen can apply for services provided by a Circle Office sitting at their home through <u>https://bwiswmuthi.bodoland.gov.in</u>. The awareness programme will try to reach out to the masses so that more people are benefitted through the mission.

Moreover, to facilitate the applicant, camps would be organised in all villages & Kisok Centre would be placed in all circle offices. Public will be educated on the land issues and will be helped by a dedicated team for availing the services, stated Hon'ble CEM of BTR, Sri Pramod Boro.

Apart from the mission objectives of delivering land related services at the doorsteps of citizens, many villages of BTC that were not surveyed since 75th year of Independence for which people were deprived of land rights and other basic services related with land, BTC has started drone flying of these villages for digitization of land records and for issuing land pattas, informed the Chief of BTC.

The present Government is committed to the aspirations of all communities residing in the council and tries to address major issues plaguing the area since many years mostly related to land, unemployment and development of its people in every aspect, stated Executive Member of the Council, Ranjit Basumatary.

Speaking on the occasion, Akash Deep, IAS, Principal Secretary, BTC expressed hope that the mission would go a long way in addressing many issues of the region pending since long. He welcomed the initiative and informed that targets will be fixed at every level of service delivery and accountability shall be fixed, as well. The programme was attended by all Executive Members and Secretaries of BTC.
